Activities for non-Italian speaking visitors

1. EDUCATIONAL TRIPS

More and more schools on educational trips choose to take advantage of the Foundation's Educational Services to explore the history, art and cultural heritage of Venice, one of the most famous cities in the world and a preferred destination for educational tourism.

To facilitate educators in the organization of educational trips and work alongside with them to make the experience an opportunity for cultural enrichment, an agreement has been finalized between "Centro Soggiorno Morosini", one of the institutions of the Municipality of Venice, and Fondazione Musei Civici with the aim to offer schools comfortable accommodation at very favourable prices. The Center, which specializes in the hosting of children and teens, is located on the Lido at Alberoni, an area of Venice suspended between sea and lagoon, well known for its quiet atmosphere, charm and natural beauty. The facilities are reserved for the exclusive use of schools during their educational trips.

Accommodation is subject to the booking of educational packages combining at least two proposals in the educational activities offered by the Foundation's museums.

2. SELF-GUIDED VISITS

THE PERFECT CRIME. FIND THE CULPRIT IN THE DOGE'S PALACE

An unusual guide book for a self-guided tour of the famous Doge's Palace and explore its rooms in this fun and playful adventure.

The tour winds through all of the most significant areas of the Palace - from the courtyard, to the State Halls, the prisons, the Doge's Apartment – in the attempt to discover the numerous clues that will shed light on an intricate affair that took place at the time of Doge Francesco Foscari.





At the end of the adventure in the Doge's Palace, the itinerary can be expanded in search of other clues leading to the Foscaris in art, literature, music, and in the most authentic Venetian places, thanks to the rich in this activity book.

The publication is also available in English, French, German and Spanish for foreign students visiting Venice, but it can also be very useful for foreign language teaching in Italian schools, because it allows each student to directly verify and reinforce what they have learned in class.

3. MUSEUM-SCHOOL

PALAZZO DUCALE - DOGE'S PALACE

Active Tours

THE HALLS OF POWER

The tour focuses primarily on the state rooms of the Doge's Palace, where the impressive series of paintings, exciting pictures, magnificent sculptures and lavish decoration evoke the complex operation of the machinery of government at the time of the Republic and also highlight the iconographic program promoted by the Venetian ruling class to establish and celebrate the myth of Venice.

THE HISTORY OF THE DOGE'S PALACE. ART AND ARCHITECTURE

The tour focuses on the history of the construction of the Palace through the analysis of the styles that characterize it, tracing in brick and stone the transformations determined by the political and functional requirements of the Venetian government and the many reconstructions following the fires that repeatedly devastated large parts of the building throughout its long history.

A ROYAL PALACE FOR ANTONIO CANOVA

The neo-classical wing of the Museum with its impressive staircase, the ballroom and other rooms that still retain the decorations of the palace built by Napoleon and completed in the years of Austrian rule provide the perfect setting against which to showcase the work of Antonio Canova.

The stately rooms contain a significant example of the artist's production, including marble sculptures, sketches, plaster casts, bas-reliefs, paintings, and the famous sculptural group *Daedalus and Icarus*, unanimously considered by critics the earliest masterpiece of modern sculpture. The educational activity proposed focuses on an in-depth analysis of this sculptural group, the masterpiece of the artist's youth, yet crucial for the formal and iconological appreciation of Canova's innovative style and ideal of beauty.

A JOURNEY INTO EIGHTEENTH-CENTURY VENICE

The extraordinary rooms of the palace, with the sumptuous furnishings and original period furniture, refined decoration, exquisite tapestries, and official portraits, offer a view of Venice when the city was still wealthy and powerful, carefree and joyous. But a careful examination of the works by the leading figures of the last great age of Venetian painting, such as Tiepolo, Canaletto, Longhi, the Guardis, will lay bare the flip side of that reality, showing Venice on the brink of the long and slippery slope to modernity.

Interactive activity sheets, teaching units, audiovisual equipment, all tailored to the type and age group of the users, will accompany the young visitors in this particular journey of discovery.

The proposed tour aims to provide interpretive categories and a cultural framework for understanding modern art from French Post-Impressionism to the Munich and Vienna Secessions, from Symbolism to Abstract Art, offering an insight into the twentieth century and its multilayered complexity through an interdisciplinary approach incorporating art, history and literature.

A more in-depth analysis may focus on the following topics:

- abstraction or nostalgia
- realism, symbolism, abstraction
- middle class and working class, women, youth
- ambiguity, ambivalence, psychology
- the art of dreams. The years of the Ca' Pesaro Biennali
- exploring sculpture
