



Rules for authorised TOURIST GUIDES accompanying groups or individual visitors



**WELCOME TO THE DOGE'S PALACE!

NOTE: For groups of more than 10 people you must use headphones and microphone (Whisper system) so that the guides can keep their voices down.

	Tutela te stesso e proteggiti gli altri rispettando le regole di visita del Museo	Protect yourself and those around you by respecting the rules when you visit the Museum
	Non accedere al museo se hai sintomi di infezioni respiratorie acute (febbre, tosse, raffreddore)	Do not enter the museum if you have any symptoms of an acute respiratory infection (fever, cough, cold)
	Indossa sempre una mascherina per la protezione di naso e bocca	Always wear a mask to protect your nose and mouth
	Lava e igienizza spesso le mani, anche se dotato di guanti, utilizzando gli appositi dispenser disinfettanti, distribuiti lungo il percorso di visita	Wash and disinfect your hands often, even if you're wearing gloves, using the sanitizer bottles distributed throughout the museum
	Tutte di toccarti occhi, naso e bocca, anche se dotato di guanti	If it makes you feel safer, you can wear a face mask during your visit
	Starnutisci o tossisci utilizzando un fazzoletto ed evitando il contatto delle mani con le secrezioni	Don't touch your eyes, nose and mouth, even if you're wearing gloves
	Tutte abbassate e strette di mano	When you sneeze, or cough use a handkerchief and make sure your hands have no direct contact with the secretions
	Segui il percorso di visita prestabilito, a senso unico, evitando di entrare nella zona di passaggio e mantenendo sempre la distanza di 1 metro dalle altre persone	Don't hug anyone or shake hands
	Puoi sederti solo nelle sedute collettive e contraddistinte da apposita segnaletica	Follow the one-way itinerary as indicated, do not linger in areas where people are passing through, and always make sure you are 1 metre away from other people
	Rispetta i limiti di capienza indicati nelle sale espositive	You may only see dawn eye visits that have the pertinent signs
	Atteenti alle indicazioni del personale nella registrazione delle code in attesa per accedere al servizio o in alcune sale espositive	Respect the limits for the number of people allowed in each room
		Follow instructions given by the staff regarding any queues waiting to use the washrooms or certain exhibition rooms



REMEMBER THAT DURING THE VISIT, ANY INDICATIONS RELATED TO THE COVID 19 HEALTH EMERGENCY ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL

IN PARTICULAR, DURING GROUP VISITS WITH A GUIDE PLEASE REMEMBER:

Both the guide and visitors have to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth



Always make sure you are 1 metre away from other people



Bulky bags, rucksacks, umbrellas and any other items that cannot be taken into the museum must be put inside the bags provided and left at the cloakroom desk free of charge.

DURING THE VISIT THROUGH THE ROOMS YOU WILL FIND THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION SIGNS:

In each room there is an indication of the maximum allowed capacity in the room and area. If necessary, the room attendants will intervene with specific indications to make sure the visitors are distributed more evenly in the rooms and areas, avoiding localised overcrowding.

You are only allowed to stop and listen to an explanation in rooms with this symbol. If there's no symbol, the explanation will be given while moving along, without stopping.

Each room has a hand sanitizer so you can disinfect your hands as often as possible
